SATS- (Standard Attainment Tests)

Key Stage 2 Test week

Monday 9 May	English reading test: reading booklet and associated answer booklet.
Tuesday 10 May	English grammar, punctuation and spelling test: Paper 1 short answer questions. English grammar, punctuation and spelling test: Paper 2 spelling.
Wednesday 11 May	Mathematics: Paper 1 arithmetic test. Mathematics: Paper 2 reasoning.
Thursday 12 May	Mathematics: Paper 3 reasoning.

Assessment

The expectation of our children has been cranked up this year for ALL children across the Country.

Content that was previously covered in year 7 and 8 is now being covered by year 6 pupils.

This is the same in all subject areas and ages.

Key Stage 2

At Ravensmead Key Stage 2 are assessed against year group expectations, which are in line with the new curriculum

Emerging, Expected, Exceeding

This enables teachers to accurately assess the 'attainment' of the children.

In addition Key Stage 2 children take standardised tests in both **Reading (PIRA)** and **Maths (PUMA)**.

This will allow us to assess your child's progress. *(comparisons against age scored on the test with chronological age).*

Throughout lessons ongoing assessment is taking place (verbally, 2 star and a wish) which is highlighted in our marking and feedback policy.

What will be reported to parents after Sats?

The previous national curriculum levels have been scrapped, and instead children will be given scaled scores. You will be given your child's **raw score (the actual number of marks they get)**, alongside their **scaled score** and whether they have reached the **national average**.

The score needed to reach the national average has yet to be announced.

Tests are being carried out in April to determine the national average
