History - The History of the local area.

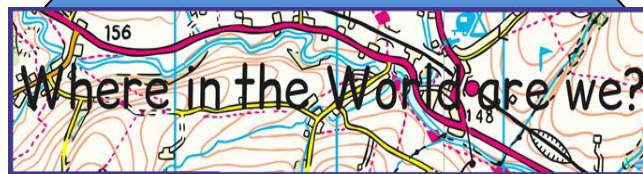
We will be learning about the area that where we live, the history of coal mining and Minnie Pit disaster.
